Welcome to the Art 1 studio where you will participate in an artist's exploration of a variety of media, concepts and processes, with a specific focus on introducing the Elements of Art.

In this class you will:

- Experiment with a variety of media and processes
- Consider the diverse purposes for making art
- Learn the Elements of Art and be introduced to the Principles of Design
- Make connection from art to other subjects and to your personal life
- Work Hard ...be on time, and on task
- Take ownership of your learning...try new things, ask for help, embrace your mistakes, creatively solve problems, learn from others
- Be Respectful...of yourself as a growing artist, of your classmates, of your teacher, of the supplies and studio
 - Take good care of art supplies.
 - Never put-down art work... your own, or a classmate's..
 - Create an environment free from distractions for yourself & your classmates (cell phones away and off, headphones to listen to music are allowed when you are working but off your head when anyone is addressing the class).
 - Food and drink should be kept away from art work.
 - Permission is required to leave class for any reason & you should remain in your assigned seat until your area is clean and you are dismissed at the end of class. You can arrange (with the teacher) to work on your art in alternate locations in the room to facilitate your success.

Materials:

All materials will be provided to you in the studio, and are paid for by your **class fee of \$15**. All students are expected to pay this fee in the Business Office by the main entrance. If this is a financial hardship, you must still get a waiver approval from the Business Office.

Grading:

Art production, including evidence of participation in the learning process through projects, note taking, and practice in your sketchbook, will make up your grades. Criteria and rubrics for each project will be clearly explained and provided to you throughout the semester, and you will participate in self evaluations.

Grading Scale: The district proficiency grade conversion scale will be used.
